OBJECTIVES

1. To legislate and make laws that will favour every Uganda in all sectors.
2. To make sure that Government budgets capture all needs of our people .ie Education, Health, Water, Roads, Agriculture, micro finance, electricity.
3. Represent people in parliament and raise matters affecting my constituents.
4. Do oversight roles such that money advanced to ministries and local governments do what it's supposed to do in far as service delivery is concerned.
5. Lobby government and other local and international Agencies, extend services that are lacking in Ibanda Municipality

ACTIONABLE AREAS:

1) CLEAN, SAFE WATER.

Ibanda is generally water stressed and most people depend on unclean water from rivers and ponds. National water is trying although a few villages have been covered. Areas in greater Nsasi Sub county, greater Kashangura , Bisheshe, Kyaruhimbi, Katongore have a problem of water scarcity.

I have together with partners started provision of boreholes mainly located at health centre and schools but serving the surrounding communities.

We have so far provided 29 boreholes with each borehole serving about 1200 people.

We shall continue providing at least 10 boreholes every year to all those villages that are water stressed. We are also starting on repairs of boreholes that were built by government.

I shall also promote harvesting of rainwater using tanks. I will do this by negotiating with financial institutions to provide cheap loans to people to be able to buy tanks and do the piping.

2) HEALTH

I will work with councilors and other leaders to monitor service delivery and make sure that drugs are available at our health centres working closely with ministry of health and the Municipal heads of department of our Health Sector.

I will also look for funding from local and international funders to improve on our laboratory services, maternity , and general services.

I will focus on building labor wards and paediatric wards.

We are currently seeking for funding to do this at Kashangura Health centre III.

3) EDUCATION

Our education needs some improvement. Performance of our candidates is not the best much as there has been some improvement.

Private schools perform better than government schools. I will therefore, start annual Municipal examinations for candidates with the help of parents and schools.

This will enhance the capacity of our children to sit for exams without panic.

I will also work with partners to get scholarships/bursaries for disadvantaged bright children.

A case in point is Ibanda University.

4) AGRICULTURE

Our people are hard working but they need some help. I will work with other municipal leaders to see to it that we get extension workers to help guide our farmers on modern practices.

I will also work closely with OWC and other agencies, government and non-government to get fertilizers for our farmers to be able to get better yields and hence more income.

Government has started on giving farmers irrigation schemes both from ministry of agriculture and ministry of water.

I will work closely with the municipal commercial officer to make cooperative s for farmers such that they are helped in production, storage and marketing.

This will help them get better prices for their produce which has always been enjoyed by a few middlemen.

5) ELECTRICITY

I will work with REA to see to it that our areas that are not connected to the national grid, get connected. These areas include, Kyabugaija, Greater Nsasi, Rwensinga, Kakatsi, Kabare, kakijerere and all other areas in need of electricity.

This will help create employment for our young people especially on cottage industries.

I will also lobby for cheap solar power for our homesteads especially for lighting purposes.

People can be given solar power and they pay in instalments.

6) SECURITY

Using my experience of working with the security system, I will work closely with the security apparatus to make sure we fight crime.

Vanilla farmers especially those from around Nyakatookyee and neighbouring have a problem of thieves and this puts their lives at risk.

I shall work with security heads in our area to establish village security teams to fight all these criminals.

7) ENVIRONMENT

I will promote planting of trees and get on board environmental friendly organisations to pay those with forests not to cut their trees for some time.

I will also work with our technical people to educate our farmers on proper farming methods that don't affect our environment.

Will work with other leaders to make sure that our wetlands are restored. I together with my colleagues have already started on the campaign to plant trees.

8) SACCOS

I will make sure that we start Saccos for Boda Boda riders, women, business community, the Disabled, youths Teachers, and Medical workers.

For the Saccos that already exist, like that for the youths, women and Teachers, I will lobby for more capitalisation like I am already lobbying 100M for the Begyesa Sacco.

I will also work closely with the commercial officer to make sure that Sacco leaders and managers are trained and given the necessary knowledge.

I will also use my banking experience and knowledge to help these saccos get skills.

8) EMPLOYMENT

I will mobilise all Ibanda people who are already in some positions to help place our youths who will have just completed school.

I will also promote cottage industries using the presidential initiative on skills and with extension of electricity to most of our areas.

I will also lobby investors to come to Ibanda such that they can provide employment to our people.

9)TOURISM

Ibanda is endowed with great tourism potential like Nyakahondogoro caves in Mabanga, Gault stones, Kibubura tomb, the equator at mile 58, Kagongo Institutions, Ibanda great hills , the New Diocese of North West Ankole Ibanda and the great food we eat like enkuru.

I will promote this tourism potential locally and internationally such that our business community benefits from the tourists.

10) ROADS AND BRIDGES

I will lobby funding from both government and NGOs to help us maintain a good road network and build bridges.

I have already lobbied an NGO that is already doing drawings to work on the following bridges, Nsasi/Kitontoma, RUYONZA/ RWOMUHORO, Nyinendugu/ Bufunda, and many others in the district.

11) SPORTS

I will personally promote local sports and Athletics. I will support clubs in sports and also lobby those that can support our different Teams playing different games.
